HOW DOES IT WORK?

The program is a hybrid of the well-recognized Mastermind Group model. Participants include senior graduates, young leaders, and experienced professionals who share a commitment to leading Canada in the transition to a low-carbon and socially-just economy.

Working collaboratively on-line and in-person over a three- to six-month period, participants set high-impact sustainability career goals, design plans to achieve them, and experience breakthrough results and success. Learning modules and facilitated discussions help guide creative and wise-decision making.


